ROOT BEER OCCASION THEATRE COMPANY'S PANDEMIC PERFORMANCE MODEL

This performance model has been reviewed and approved by Paola Garza, Registered Nurse.

– QUARANTINE –––

All in-person participants MUST quarantine in their own homes for two weeks leading up to the event *OR* from their last negative COVID19 test. This means:

- STAY HOME
- Buy groceries ahead of time or arrange for no-contact food delivery
- Do not have any visitors

If any participants have roommates who will be coming/going from their homes into public spaces, we ask that they practice in-house distancing. This means:

- Quarantining in their own rooms as best they can
- Using a separate bathroom if available
- Not having any close contact with anyone else in the house (including pets, unless the pet is quarantined in the room with the participant)
- Disinfecting any shared surfaces before and after use

All in-person participants are required to take their temperature twice a day and log their results on a shared platform. <u>Any COVID19 symptoms MUST be reported to our team.</u>

Any participant who experiences COVID19 symptoms during the quarantine period will be removed from the project and paid a percentage of their honorarium.

——— THE DAY OF THE SHOW —

Transportation

We will personally transport all actors to and from our venue.

- Our driver will be a member of our festival crew, which means they will have abided by the same quarantine measures mentioned above.
- No one will be allowed in the vehicle without passing a temperature check, administered by our driver using a sanitized forehead thermometer.
- Maximum vehicle capacity will be limited to four (4) at a time, including driver.
- Everyone will be required to wear masks inside the vehicle.

The Performance

Actors will <u>not</u> wear masks during the performances, but each play will be blocked so actors remain six feet apart.

- Exceptions will be made to this rule only by unanimous agreement and special circumstance (i.e. if two actors have been quarantining together.)
- Thusly, all plays have been required to include no physical intimacy or interpersonal contact, and there is a limit of three (3) actors per show.
- Actors will not be required to touch shared surfaces with their bare hands.
- All props will be sanitized, stored separately, and never passed between actors.
- Crew (including director and SM) will be wearing masks and gloves for the duration of the performance. Gloves will be changed between each scene/play.
- All surfaces within each set will be sanitized between each scene/play, and soft surfaces (i.e. couch coverings, cushions, etc.) will be switched out by our crew.

Day-of Downtime

- Actors will have access to a sanitized 'green room' while waiting.
- There will be a limit of three (3) actors per green room.
- Seats will be pre-designated so actors remain at least six feet apart.
- While in these spaces, we strongly encourage actors to wear masks and gloves.
- Snacks and drinks will be provided in individual packaging.
- We will have two sanitized restrooms for actor use.

Liability

Though we will take every possible precaution to ensure the health and safety of our team, Root Beer Occasion Theatre Company LLC is not liable for any personal injury or infirmary that occurs during the event.

ALL in-person cast and crew members MUST sign a contract agreeing to abide by these safety regulations.
